Like City Centre, Northern Tallinn this is one of the most diverse districts both architecturally, historically and socially. One of the oldest settlements of Tallinn is situated here - Kalamaja with 1 to 2-storey wooden houses, Pelgulin with more modern wooden buildings and areas of multi-storey houses (Pelgurand which was established in the fifties). Being mostly located on a peninsula, North Tallinn has a big development potential. There are many industrial enterprises, ports and railway transport establishments.
